Visits:

- Use for direct patient care
- Choose one per visit
- Add ICD-9 Code

Indirect Care:

- Use for indirect patient care
- Add ICD-9 Code

- Use as add on or stand-alone
- Add ICD-9 if needed
- Can use multiple per visit

Visits:

- **Consultations** are a comprehensive visits requested from another provider. This includes history and physical examination, review of imaging and laboratory findings, and a written report or plan of care to the referring practitioner
- **Counselling** is used when the only purpose of the visit is to provide counselling
- **Complete Examination** is for the first visit that includes complete history and physical, review of records and care planning. It doesn't have to be done on the first visit but should only be used once per patient
- **Obstetrics** includes all visits providing prenatal and postpartum services

Indirect Care:

- Complex Care Activities is a catch-all for the work we do with patients outside of the patient visit. This must include a chart note and relevant ICD-9

Examples:

- Family conference, case conference with team
- Care planning (eg. palliative, mental health)
- Forms
- Chart reviews

Extras:

- Counselling can be used as an add-on when a visit goes longer due to crisis or emotional distress. Do not use for general education/counselling in a regular visit.
- Complex Care Activities can be used as an add on when extra activities are done during the visit (eg. forms, yearly complex disease planning)
- Complex Care Activities can be entered in as a separate billing when the patient has more than 3 ICD-9 diagnoses
- Minor Surgery/Procedures
 - Sutures, I&D, Cryo, Toenail removal, IUD, Biopsy, Splinting
- Non-Invasive Tests/Procedures
 - Pap, Ear syringing, Injections (not immunizations)
- NP Pathology/Diagnostic Activities are not coded if done by a lab, MOA or RN (except INR)
 - Urine Dip, INR interpretation and adjustments
 - Drug screen testing, Pregnancy test
 - Glucose test, ECG
